AWARENESS ABOUT PERSONAL HYGIENE GIVEN TO SCHOOL STUDENTS:

Students and Staff members spoke to them about the importance of Personal hygiene and cleanliness. Maintaining good personal hygiene is the first step to good health.

Personal hygiene is generally defined as cleanliness of the body and proper maintenance of personal appearance. Practicing good body hygiene also helps us to feel good about our self, which is also important for our mental health.

They emphasized on the importance of Oral health Care, toilet hygiene, hair care etc.

The importance of these activities as a part of everyday routine was taught to the gathering.

Bath daily:-

A regular bath every morning helps in keeping us clean, fresh and odor free.

Wash your hands:-

They elaborated on washing their hands before and after meals, after using washroom, sneezing or coughing, after handling garbage, touching an animal and explained the methods on how to clean hands thoroughly with clean soap and water. They also tells that it prevents the spread of bacteria and viruses.

Trim your nails:-

Keeping our finger and toe nails trimmed and brushing them daily with soap so that no dirt or residue remains beneath the nail.

Practice good oral hygiene:-

The mouth is the area of the body most prone to collecting harmful bacteria and generating infections. To minimize the accumulation of bacteria in our mouth (which cause tooth decay and gum disease), brush our teeth at least twice a day. It will also help to prevent bad breath.

Take care of your hair:-

Washing our hair at least every alternate day is important to keeping our hair and scalp healthy and in good shape. Get a haircut frequently for a healthy hair. Ladies with long hair are often suffering from lice or dandruff, and then they should take necessary action to clear them at the earliest.

Wear clean clothes:

Wear a fresh set of clothes as often as possible. Dirty clothes are a source of contamination and can cause very serious skin disorders if worn over without washing them. Wash clothing on a regular basis.

Cleaning our ears and eyes

Children who live in unhygienic conditions and have poor personal hygiene are prone to illnesses as their immune system is not as strong as that of the adults.

3. Programme Title: Extension Activity-Transect walk at Molapalayam

4. Details of the programme:

Department of Biotechnology arranged the extension activity to visit the adopted village Molapalayam on 21.10.2022. We (50 Students + 03 Staff Members) started our journey at 10.10 a.m. from our college and reach to Molapalayam and then we met the village President at Molapalayam. We honored the President with shawl. After that, the President explained about of the village, functioning of the Panchayat and its facilities. In addition to this, our students made an Observatory walk (Transect Walk) to all the streets of the village Molapalayam. Students are planted tree saplings. During this walk, Students observed and making notes of the layout of the village - housing, drainage, backyards, infrastructure etc., Our students were divided into four groups and initiated their work based on their objectives (Mapping, housing, Water Resources, drainage etc.,). The Detail as follows,

MAPPING



SANITATION

Waste water tanks

- ➤ Water storage tanks are contaminated that contain lot of larvae and that can cause disease like Dengue, Malaria and Cholera.
- Contaminated water supplies have been responsible for major outbreaks of severe gastrointestinal illness such as gastroenteritis and other infections caused by the protozoans

Solution

The storage tanks have to be cleaned at least once a most with liberal use of bleaching powder to check accumulation of sediment and slime (algae).

Sewage

- ➤ Contamination of drinking water sources by sewage can occur from raw sewage overflow.
- > Septic tanks, Leaking sewer lines, Land application of sludge and partially treated waste water.
- The disease involves from sewages water causes Diarrhea, Hepatitis A, Gastroenteritis.
- > Sewage water discharged from only local peoples not from any of the chemical industries.

Disposal waste

- ➤ Most household waste in villages is organic, and some of them by little inorganic material, and it is non toxic to living.
- Friendliness composting is a highly suitable method of waste management in rural areas.

Solid waste

Hazard waste

- The Molapalayam area we explored they are dumb or burn the plastic waste like plastic carry bags, plastic containers, plastic bottles, etc.., without any proper procedure.
- In some places they were throw the waste materials into the ruined wells.

Bio - waste

- ➤ Bio waste like cow dunk, plant waste (leaves, branches) dumb in pit.
- ➤ Household cooking wastes like vegetable, fruits where throw into garbage bin

Liquid waste

House hold water

➤ Waste water like house hold (shower, dishwash, laundry water) were freely flow on the streets and some of the places they were use the waste water for the plant growth.

1. Tapioca (Maravalli Kilangu)- Duration: 10-12 months.

Problem Identification

Affected by Mealy bugs (white fly in leaf)

It affects crop yield & leads to death of the plant.

Problem statement

White fly that are not controlled by pesticides.

Application of Manure

Fertilizers: Organic & Inorganic are used.

Irrigation method

Trip fertilization are mostly used.

2. Onion -Duration: 3months

Problem Identification

Harvested in rainy seasons. (Little amount get wasted)

Harvested in summer season are stored and later they are shown.

In red soil Onion yield is good comparing to the other soil.

Disease that are controlled by Pesticides.

Application of manure

Fertilizers: Organic & Inorganic are used.

Irrigation method

Trip facilities and some by Human.

3. Cotton- Duration: 6 months.

Problem Identification

Over rain or over moist content leads to flower fall and seed fall.

Less amount of moist content also affect the crop yield.

Disease that are controlled by pesticides.

Problem statement

After 4-5 months of plant, insects arrive in seed are not controlled by pesticides.

Application of Manure

Fertilizers: Organic and Inorganic are used.

Irrigation method

Trip facilities and some by Human.

4. Groundnut-Duration: 3-4 months.

Problem identification:

It grows well in red soil.

Groundnut mills are located inside the village.

Problem statement

Insects are controlled by pesticides.

Application of Manure

Fertilizers: Organic and Inorganic are used.

Irrigation method

Most of the plant grow by rain and some plants by trips and by human.

5. Corn-Duration: 4months.

Problem identification

In corn leaf, the worms that eat the leaf and enter into the corn.

The yield of the crop is decreased.

Problem statement

Worms that are not controlled by pesticides.

Application of Manure

Fertilizers: organic and mostly use inorganic.

Irrigation method

It consumes more water comparing to other plant.

By trip facilities it produces low yield.

It is done by direct water to plant by human.

6. Sorghum-Duration: 3 months

Problem identification

Continuous raining leads to red spot in the leaf & the plant not grow well.

Harvested of the crops use as animal feed.

Problem statement

Insects are controlled by pesticides.

Irrigation method

Trip facilities and some by Human.

7. Coconut-Duration: Up to 70-80 years.

Problem statement

The white flies, that affect the leaves of the tree.

It affects the yield of the tree.

Problem identification

The white flies that arrive one year back.

Still now they did not use any pesticides.

Now a days the flies spread more.

Application of Manure

Fertilizers: Mostly used organic and less amount by Inorganic.

Irrigation method

Direct water to plant it produce more yield, and by trip it produce less yield.

8. Animal Husbandry (Goat farm)

Sorghum is used as feed in greenish, groundnut leaf are used as feed.

Goat farm are maintained in shelter.

Every month they are get vaccinated, to prevent from disease.

9. Water Resources


In summer season the water content is too low.

OBJECTIVE:

To promote the awareness among the students about the spread of Aids

and preventive measures of HIV.

TOPIC DEALT WITH:

HIV stands for human immunodeficiency virus. If left untreated, HIV can lead to the

disease AIDS (acquired immunodeficiency syndrome).

Unlike some other viruses, the human body can't get rid of HIV completely. So once you have

HIV, you have it for life.

HIV attacks the body's immune system, specifically the CD4 cells (T cells), which help

the immune system fight off infections. If left untreated, HIV reduces the number of CD4 cells

(T cells) in the body, making the person more likely to get infections or infection-related cancers.

Over time, HIV can destroy so many of these cells that the body can't fight off infections

and disease. These opportunistic infections or cancers take advantage of a very weak immune

system and signal that the person has AIDS, the last state of HIV infection.

No effective cure for HIV currently exists, but with proper treatment and medical care, HIV can be controlled.

The medicine used to treat HIV is called antiretroviral therapy or ART. If taken the right way, every day, this medicine can dramatically prolong the lives of many people with HIV, keep them healthy, and greatly lower their chance of transmitting the virus to others. Today, a person who is diagnosed with HIV, treated before the disease is far advanced, and stays on treatment can live a nearly as long as someone who does not have HIV.

AIDS stands for acquired immunodeficiency syndrome. AIDS is the final stage of HIV infection, and not everyone who has HIV advances to this stage.

AIDS is the stage of infection that occurs when your immune system is badly damaged and you become vulnerable to *opportunistic infections*. When the number of your CD4 cells falls below 200 cells per cubic millimeter of blood

HIV is not spread easily. Only certain body fluids from a person who has HIV can transmit HIV:

- Blood
- Semen (cum)
- Pre-seminal fluid (pre-cum)
- Rectal fluids
- Vaginal fluids
- Breast milk

•

These body fluids must come into contact with a mucous membrane or damaged tissue or be directly injected into your bloodstream (by a needle or syringe) for transmission to occur. Mucous membranes are found inside the rectum, vagina, penis, and mouth.

HIV does not survive long outside the human body (such as on surfaces) and it cannot reproduce outside a human host. It **is not** spread by:

- Air or water
- Mosquitoes, ticks or other insects
- Saliva, tears, or sweat that is not mixed with the blood of an HIV-positive person
- Shaking hands, hugging, sharing toilets, sharing dishes/drinking glasses, or closed-mouth or "social" kissing with someone who is HIV-positive

- Drinking fountains
- Other sexual activities that don't involve the exchange of body fluids (for example, touching).





TOPIC DEALT WITH:

1. First aid:

- First aid is the assistance given to any person suffering a sudden illness or injury
- First aid is generally performed by the <u>layperson</u>, with many people trained in providing basic levels of first aid, and others willing to do so from acquired knowledge
- There are many situations which may require first aid, and many countries have legislation, regulation, or guidance which specifies a minimum level of first aid provision in certain circumstances
- Preserve life: the overriding aim of all medical care which includes first aid, is to save lives and minimize the threat of death.
- Prevent further harm: also sometimes called prevent the condition from worsening, or danger of further injury, this covers both external factors, such as moving a patient away from any cause of harm, and applying first aid techniques to prevent worsening of the condition, such as applying pressure to stop a bleed becoming dangerous

2. Hypertension:

- Hypertension also known as high blood pressure (HBP), is a long term medical condition in which the blood pressure in the arteries is persistently elevated.
- Blood pressure is expressed by two measurements,
 the systolic and diastolic pressures, which are the maximum and minimum pressures
- Normal blood pressure at rest is within the range of 100–140 millimeters
 mercury (mmHg) systolic and 60–90 mmHg diastolic

 High blood pressure is present if the resting blood pressure is persistently at or above 140/90 mmHg for most adults

3. CPR (Cardiopulmonary resuscitation)

- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation, commonly known as CPR, is an <u>emergency</u> <u>procedure</u> that combines chest compression often with <u>artificial ventilation</u> in an effort to manually preserve intact brain function until further measures are taken to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person who is in <u>cardiac arrest</u>. It is <u>indicated</u> in those who are unresponsive with no breathing or abnormal breathing
- CPR alone is unlikely to restart the heart; Its main purpose is to restore partial flow of oxygenated blood to the <u>brain</u> and <u>heart</u>.
- The objective is to delay <u>tissue death</u> and to extend the brief window of opportunity for a successful resuscitation without permanent <u>brain damage</u>
