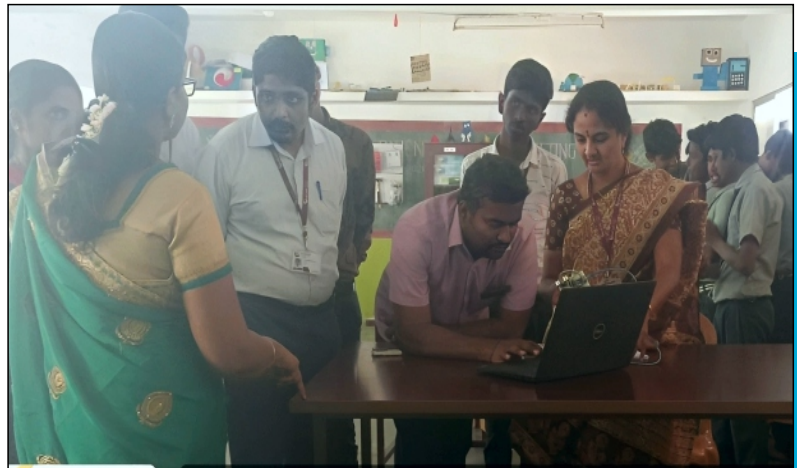
## Faculty Participation in Virtual FDP on OBE

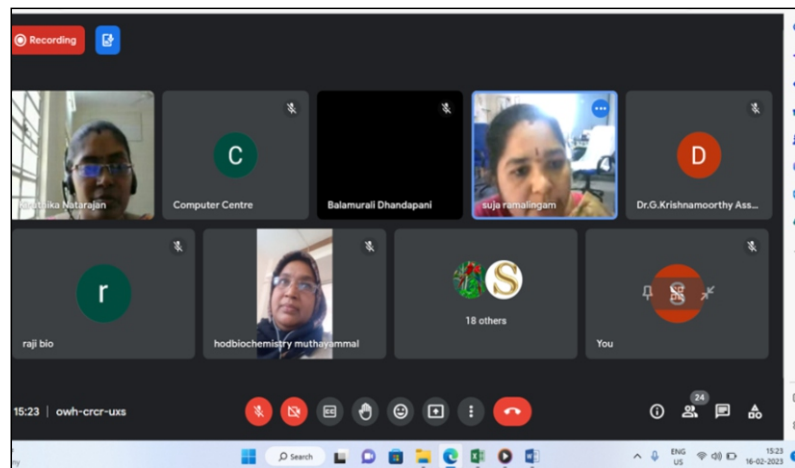
## Field Visit

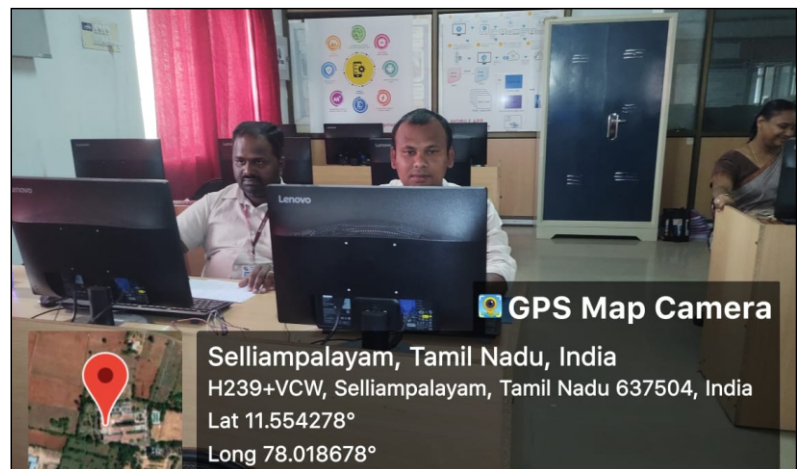


## Hands on Training
