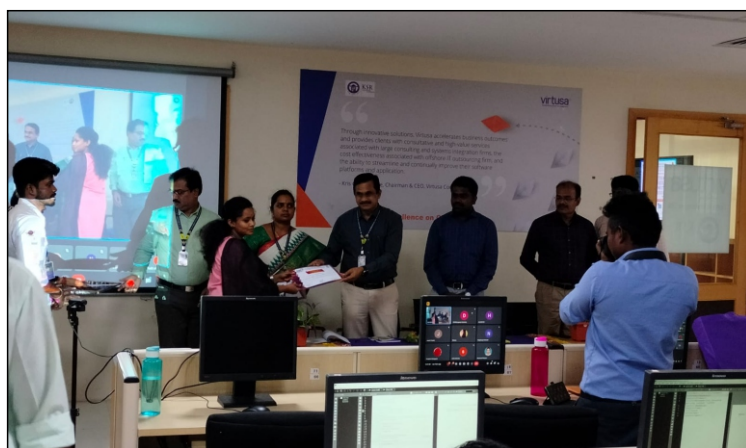


TNPSC- FOREST ZOOLOGY EXAMINATION

Institution's Innovation Council(IIC)

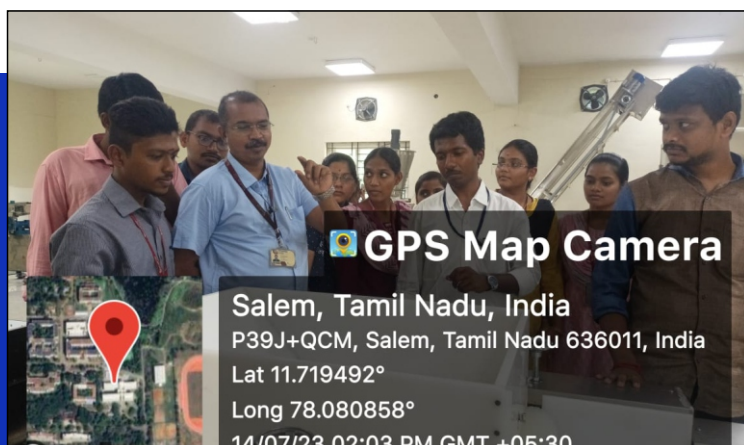
INNOVATION ECOSYSTEM ENABLER ON NOVEL APPLICATION OF AI

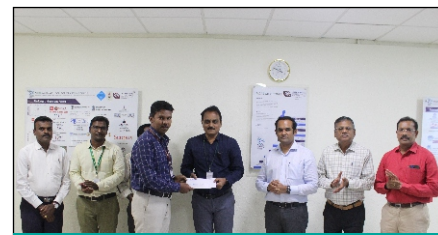

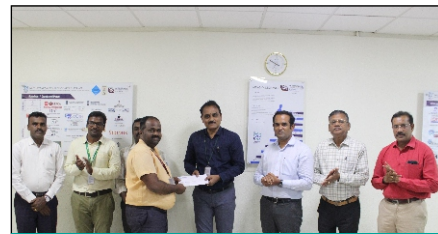
