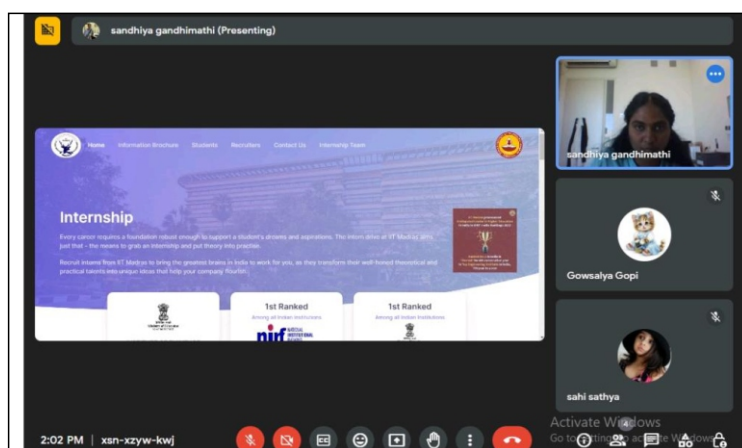
## PARTICIPATION IN WORKSHOP

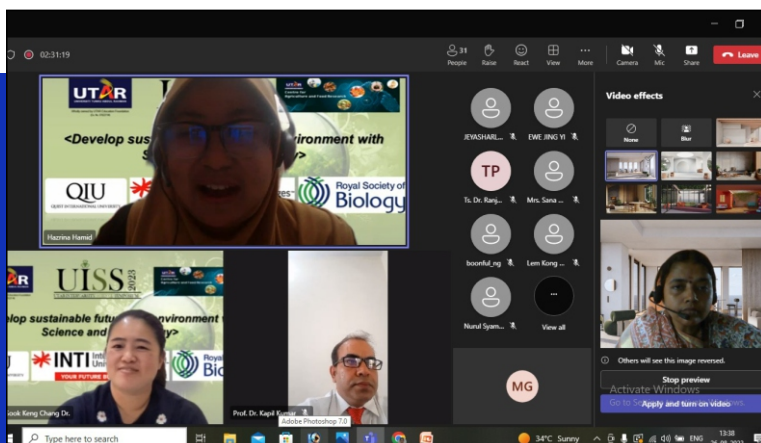
### WORKSHOP ON POSH

## REGIONAL WORKSHOP

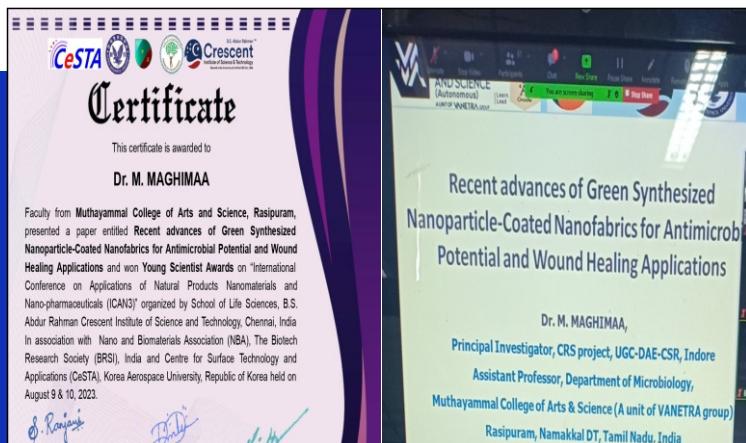
