Established in the year 1994, it offered five Undergraduate Degree courses with 83 students and a meager amount of the teaching fraternity. Today, there is a drastic improvement in terms of strength. The total number of teaching on the roll is 244 (including ML: 14 Staff Members) and the Non-Teaching staff members are 41 in number. The college obviously shows a gradual upward movement in terms of Admission. The number has by and large augmented (**Total Strength: 4939** - Men: 2712 Women: 2202 (UG-4422; PG-492; M.Phil-17; Ph.D-08).

Though our college is situated in a barren terrain backward area, it attracts the attention of stakeholders.
